We all love the game of mahjong, and MCR and riichi have equal status. We need EMA to evolve, and I want to work for that.

11. Presentation by Wenlong Li, General Secretary of the IMSA

Thanks for the invitation. I was happy to join the referee seminar, and become a certified EMA referee.

IMSA, International Mind Sport Association under IOC umbrella. Esports Federation has joined IMSA. Poker Federation is under consideration. Attracting a younger audience. 3 cities are applying for hosting the next IMSA games, and mahjong will part of it. Will allow for more support. Int



Esports Federation will make an online platform for mahjong and work to include it in Asian Games.

MIL is cooperating with Hanzhou, support and recognization from local authorities, and Taipei has a party working to make mahjong a recognised sport. MIL has promoted the Duplicate Format which is recognised by IMSA, finals and global events must be in duplicate format. It is a format, like round robin.

MIL support both MCR and RCR (riichi rules). 30.000 active MCR players in China, for other rules, millions of players.

I could not come to WRC due to COVID but MIL supported 8 participants from South America.

Cooperation with Hanzhou on MCR, RCR and Sichuan rules. Skill level certification. 3 million players have applied. Live broadcasting on tiktok, 1 million viewers every day. Valuable for stakeholders.

Presentation by Gemma Sakamoto on WRC

Played since 2006. Qualified as professional player in Japan in 2013.

WRC events in 2014 Paris, 2017 Las Vegas

2022 Vienna. 2025 Tokyo

Vienna saw a lot of teamwork between Europe and Japan. Good media exposure, including a documentary Mind Games: The Experiment available on youtube, JPML channel Mondo and Fairpoint Production.

WRC rules by Sylvain Malbec 2013. Currently on version 3.

WRC rules used widely throughout Americas and Australia

WRC Red with Red fives - a document is being finalised.

Also working to align with M League.

We are aware of proportionality, we have heard views that penalties are too severe, it may limit who wants to adopt the rules.
