Playing schedule: 2 days, 6 rounds (3+3) of 120 minutes.

Location: The venue was excellent, lots of space, quite and enough free parking spaces

Information / communication during the tournament: Visible clock projected from a computer on a screen. A gong clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session displayed on paper.

Sessions: Good playing atmosphere.

Catering: Lunch in the same place (local food catered by the restaurant that was part of the venue); water, tea and coffee for free. During the brakes cakes were served. Other beverages could be ordered and paid seperately.

Prizes: Prizes for individual ranking (top 3 players with prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd), one for the German Champion (best German player).

Conclusion: It was a good tournament with a very friendly atmosphere and an organisation that could be qualified as very efficient and professional with staff that was asking for "things to improve" for their next tournament. Job well done.
