Playing schedule: 1 day, 4 rounds of 90 minutes

Location: Schützenhof in Edewecht. Large room with ok space between tables and surrounding

areas

Equipment: rectangle tables and same mcr sets. Some tables had smooth surface (blue nylon).

Refereeing: Heike Schäefer.

Complaints: 2 players from Netherlands was 20 minutes delayed in driving from home to the venue, due to wrong setting of the clock (change to winter-time).

But we were back to schedule after 2 rounds

Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock projected from a computer on a screen. A gong clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session, printed and posted on wall.

Sessions: Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: Big warm buffet at lunch in a separate room. Beer, wine and soft drinks to buy. Between rounds there where free coffee, tea, water, candy, biscuits – and excellent home baked cakes.

Prizes: Trophies and DMJL-year mug for individual ranking (1st, 2nd and 3rd). Price for last ranked player. Overall price for participating In both tournaments (Saturday and Sunday)

Conclusion: Nice and cozy tournament, with both rule-sets (RCR and MCR) over 2 days. Everything was well organized, even transportation after the tournament to city with good bus/train transport on a Sunday. Last bus from the little city on Sunday was before end of last round.
