Equipment: We played with unmarked tiles and very functional tables with a smooth border. We had tables from $80 \times 80 \text{ cm}$, and tables from $70 \times 70 \text{ cm}$. We had enough space and no disturbing sound from the other tables. All the tiles has the same size, only one table has more little tiles.

A sound signalized clearly the start and the end of each session. The time was projected very large on a big screen. I didn't understand however why the time was given in thousands of seconds (2:00:00:00) The East-direction was shown on a paper on the table.

Refereeing: Marco Montebelli from Italy was the referee. No complaint was formulated.
