Participants: 28 players: 21 from Germany, 4 from The Netherlands, 2 from Belgium and 1 from China.

Playing schedule: 1 day, 4 rounds of 90 minutes.

Location: A hall in the local restaurant Schützenhof in Edewecht

Equipment: We played on mahjongtables with good sets of tiles. Every table had the same set.

Refereeing: Elke Pünjer was not-playing referee.

Complaints: None.

Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock projected from a computer on a screen. A gong clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session, printed and posted on walls.

Sessions: Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: A good hot lunch was served in the adjacent room after the second round. During the day there were sweets and homemade cakes, coffee and tea. Bottles of water were also available.

Prizes: Trophies for individual ranking (1st, 2nd and 3rd) and a special prize for the last place: a wildcard for next year. Some small prizes were available for special hands.

Conclusion: A very nice tournament in Germany. It's part of a "double-tournament". The day before there was a richi tournament at the same location.

It's always a friendly and pleasant tournament. It would be nice if more players participate.
