Participants: 80 players, from 8 countries

Italy (47), France (21), Switzerland (5), Spain (3),

and 1 player from Great Britain, Austria, Ukraine and Singapore

Playing schedule: 2 days, 7 rounds (4+3) of 115 minutes

Location: La casa dei Giochi, in 2 separate rooms, large enough for all players

Equipment: We played with good games and tables.

Refereeing: Cédric Aguerre, Alberto Rosi and Marco Montebelli, all players referees.

Complaints: few players complain about noisy children during the games and one about players

referees.

Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock on the screen of a computer in each room. Ranking up to date between each session.

Sessions: Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: Lunch in the same place in a different room (Italian dishes), drinks and others. Only one coffee break during all tournament.

Prizes: Trophies for individual ranking (1st to 10th), one more for the best team. Special prizes for best hands and Italian champions.
