Playing schedule: 2 days, 8 rounds (4+4) of 90 minutes

Location: The Guildford Masonic Centre. A spacious and comfortable venue, featuring a charming outdoor wooden deck that overlooks the British countryside - a perfect and relaxing spot to unwind between games.

Equipment: We played using junk mats and standard mahjong sets, all in excellent condition.

Refereeing: John Duckworth as a non-playing Head referee + 2 playing referees.

Information / communication during the tournament: A visible clock was projected onto a large screen, with a clear gong sound and announcement marking the end of each round. Scores were displayed both on-screen and on the tournament website.

Sessions: A competitive yet light-hearted atmosphere, defined by fairness, friendliness, and fun.

Catering: Lunch and dessert were included and served at the venue. Beer and soft drinks for purchase.

Prizes: Trophies for individual ranking (1st, 2nd, and 3rd), and for best British player. Extra prizes for biggest hand and greatest recovery day 2.
