Playing schedule: 1 day, 4 rounds of 120 minutes (after 115 minutes a gong sounded and the current hand was finished).

Location: Haraldsgade 69, Copenhagen – nice, spacious space, with an easy access from the nearby metro line.

Equipment: We played with sets in very good condition, the same goes to the tables. One tile in a set had a mark and was replaced under referee supervision.

Refereeing: Jesper Nøhr was non-playing referee.

Complaints: None.

Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock projected from a computer on a wall. An announcement from the organization team clearly informed players of the start and the end of sessions using a gong and verbal information. Ranking up to date between each session, printed and hanged on the wall in several places.

Sessions: Very smooth play, excellent atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: Lunch on-site included warm sandwiches served in pitas. Snacks were also provided between sessions, along with constant access to hot and cold beverages.

Prizes: Trophies and gifts for individual ranking (1st, 2nd and 3rd).
