Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock projected from a computer on a screen. A gong clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session, printed and posted on walls.

Sessions: Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: Lunch in the same place (sandwiches), drinks and others. Persian restaurant in the Saturday evening.

Prizes: Trophies for individual ranking (1st, 2nd and 3rd), and one more for the best team.

Conclusion: Very nice tournament in Copenhagen, with a very good weather (Rare enough to underline it). It is a pity there are not more players of the bordering countries such as Sweden or Netherlands.
