Playing schedule: 2 days, 8 rounds (4+4) of 90 minutes, 75 minute with 15 minutes for finishing the game

Location: The Tampere university of Technology. Easily reached from city centre by bus. Room was big enough and table have enough place between them.

Equipment: All tables used standard Japanese sets. Scoring stick were used and extra sticks could be borrowed from the referee.

Refereeing: One non-playing referee.

Complaints: None.

Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock projected from a computer on a wall. A referee clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session and seating printed and putted on doors.

Sessions: FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: Lunch was not included. Drinks (soft drinks, tea with electric kettle), water, snacks and fruits were available during tournament.

Prizes: Trophies for individual ranking (1st, 2nd and 3rd), and snack bars for each Yakuman.
