Playing schedule: 2 days, 6 rounds (4+2) of 120 minutes

Location: The “Ecole d’Ingénieurs” in Villejuif is large enough to host 100 players and leave enough space between them on the -1 floor. There is also place to have a pause or to eat on the ground floor, and some places outside to have fresh air between the sessions.

Equipment: We played with different game sets (among them, some sets of the OEMC 2014) and tables.

Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock projected from a computer on a screen. A gong clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session, projected on screen.

Sessions: Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: Breakfast and lunch in the same place on the Sunday. Drinks, coffee, cakes, and fruits between the sessions.

Prizes: Trophies for individual ranking (1st, 2nd and 3rd), and one more for the best team.
